

Nelson Mandela Bay Stadium: Venues for classes, tests and exams

Important Information November 2016

1. There will be very **strict security control** in place. This means:
 - a. Shuttle pick up points will be operational for students in residence and accredited off campus residences. Shuttle pick up and return arrangements are attached in a separate file.
 - b. Students not using the NMMU shuttle service must be dropped/park in the area beyond the Stadium. No parking for students will be allowed in the Stadium itself. Students must make their way down Milner Road towards the Lake. Access to the Stadium is via the Lakeside access point – please note this is not a major Stadium entrance but has been specifically established for NMMU students (see attached map with the GPS coordinates. The green arrow on the map is where you need to start the security procedure).
 - c. Students will have to arrive at least 1 hour before the designated lecture/test time as access control will require presentation of a valid student card. Students who have lost their student card will not be allowed to gain access to the Stadium. So, students that have lost their student card should apply for a replacement card through Theo Zeelie on the North campus, before they try to access the Stadium.
 - d. The normal security process for the Stadium will be in operation.
2. There's a **computer lab** (in North Lounge, Level 5) for students and have 20 laptops students can use in the venue. There are tables and chairs here and there if students want to work. The area in and around the computer lab has been setup for **NMMU Wi-Fi**, so connectivity won't be a problem.
3. Counselling, disability and Campus Health services will be available particularly for students on Level 5 in the area around the North Lounge Computer lounge.
4. Light beverages and snacks are available to buy from Stadium staff on Level 5. We are encouraging everyone to bring their own lunch and snacks.
5. Being a green building, there is strictly no smoking in the Stadium itself (this includes lecture venues, corridors, passages, toilets, sitting in the stands, etc.). Those who want to smoke must walk to Level 2 and smoke outside the building.
