COVID 19 and Disaster Displacement

- One-third of the world's internally displaced live in the 10 countries most atrisk to COVID-19.
- three crises rolled into one, a health crisis, a socio-economic crisis,
- Displaced populations often have precarious livelihoods, reduced or no access to social safety nets and health services. These vulnerabilities are exacerbated for those in "climate hotspots".

Climate change and Health

- Ensuring universal health coverage through well-resourced, equitable health systems, is essential to protect the public from both short and long-term health threats.
- Inequality is a major barrier in ensuring health and wellbeing, especially for the most vulnerable in society
- Ensuring access to the environmental determinants of health, such as clean air, water and sanitation, safe and nutritious food, is an essential protection against all health risks.
